Tourism staffer wins international award

Oregon City, Ore. – Annie Austin, Communications Lead for Clackamas County Tourism & Cultural Affairs, branded as Oregon's Mt. Hood Territory, received the inaugural Women in Travel and Tourism International (WITTI) Award for Rising Star in Travel and Tourism. Austin received the award at a ceremony during the annual IPW travel show in Washington DC, the largest travel show in the United States, on Sunday, June 4.

Highlights from Austin's efforts that earned her this prestigious award include a media deskside strategy that increased coverage of lodging properties by more than 400% and increased mentions of Mt. Hood Territory's website by 1,000%. The strategies she's devised are directly responsible for dramatically increasing media coverage for the region during her five years with the organization. She also created the agency's social media program, which has grown enough to necessitate additional staff and won multiple awards as well. These numbers are lauded by Austin's supervisors.
